| 5 points | How to take action: What can students do to take action on this issue? |
| 5 points | Explore the resources: where can students go to learn more? (Make it EASY for students to find more info by giving them a website or QR code so they can take a picture to go find out more) |
| 5 points | At least 2-3 pictures or graphs to make your case |
| 10 points | Poster should be creative, colorful, and interesting so it catches and holds attention! |
